Set the time in Windows 7

Your computer's clock is used to record the time whenever you create or modify files on your computer. You can change the clock's time and time zone.

Click the Date and Time tab, and then click Change date and time. If you are prompted for an administrator password or confirmation, type the password or provide confirmation.

In the Date and Time Settings dialog box, do one or more of the following:

To change the hour, double-click the hour, and then click the arrows to increase or decrease the value.

To change the minutes, double-click the minutes, and then click the arrows to increase or decrease the value.

To change the seconds, double-click the seconds, and then click the arrows to increase or decrease the value.

When you have finished changing the time settings, click OK.

To change the time zone, click Change time zone.

In the Time Zone Settings dialog box, click your current time zone in the drop-down list, and then click OK.

Note

If your time zone observes daylight saving time and you want your computer's clock to be adjusted automatically when daylight saving time changes, make sure the Automatically adjust clock for Daylight Saving Time check box is selected. (See picture 4) Click OK


Step 1 Click the Date and Time tab





Step 2 click change date and time

Insert the current date and time

Click where you want to insert the date or time.

On the **Insert** menu, click **Date and Time**.

If you want to insert the date or time in a different language format, then click the language in the **Language** box.

The **Language** box includes a list of the enabled editing languages. Additional date and time options may also be available, depending on the language that you selected.

In the **Available formats** box, click a date or time format.

1. Select whether you want the date to automatically update or to remain as originally inserted. Do one of the following:

To insert the date and time as a [field](#) that's automatically updated when you open or print the document, select the **Update automatically** check box.

To maintain the original date and time as static text, clear the **Update automatically** check box.

Sometimes when you repair your local area connection from the local area connection status window, you find out that your DNS cache could not be cleared and whatever you do, the cache will not clear up. So here's the cool way of doing it..

Open your command prompt and type the following command:

C:>net stop dnscache

If it says that the dnscache is not started then type the following command:

C:>net start dnscache

It will start your local dns cache. Now try flushing your dns cache by issuing the following command:

C:>ipconfig /flushdns

It will most probably clear your dns cache and display the results for you.

If you want to see what is in your local dns cache at this time, issue this command to find out:

C:>ipconfig /displaydns


